


E Moving a Student In ALEKS

Once a student has been enrolled in a course in ALEKS, he/she can be MOVED to a different class without consuming another subscription.

Moving to a different class – same teacher: If the student is being moved from one class to another under the same teacher, the teacher can make that move:

1. Create the class you want to move him/her into.
2. Go back to the class where he/she is currently enrolled.
3. Under Class Administration, select “Class Roster”
4. Click the box next to the student’s name
5. Choose “Move” in the black bar above the roster

6. Select the course to which he/she should be moved

Moving to a different teacher – same school: A school-level ALEKS administrator would need to move a student from one teacher to another at the same school.
